Arrest Activity

On March 20, 2009 at 5:30 p.m. Officer Blaise Lalli stopped a motor vehicle on Onset Avenue at the Point Independence Bridge. As he approached the vehicle, he observed the operator attempting to put something under the seat. The operator was asked about his furtive movements and if he had any drugs. He handed the officer a small bag of marijuana. A subsequent search of the vehicle, netted additional marijuana, 25 percocet pills and a canister of pepper spray that the suspect did not have a FID Card authorizing him to Possess. The operator Trayce M. Crew, 32 Grandview Avenue Onset was placed under arrest and charged with Possession of a Class B Substance and Possession of Mace without a FID Card. He was issued a civil citation for possession of marijuana.

On March 20, 2009 at 5:45 p.m. Officer Bryan Whalen observed a motor vehicle pass him on Main Street and the passenger, who was known to Officer Whalen, was drinking a Coors beer. He stopped the motor vehicle. Assisted by Officer Christopher Smith the located 2- 30 packs of Coors Beer, a digital scale, a marijuana grinder and two bags of a green leafy substance consistent with marijuana. Three subjects were placed under arrest. The operator, Skylar Race, 18, 171 Cromesett Road, Wareham was charged with Possession of a Class D substance with intent to distribute, Minor in Possession of Alcohol, Open container of alcohol in a motor vehicle. Justin Millette, 18, 2220 Cranberry Highway West Wareham, and Peter Lydon, 18, 25 Windsor Drive Wareham were charged with Minor in Possession of Alcohol.

On March 21, 2009, at 2:30 p.m. Officer Kearney was dispatched to the 7-11 at 3107 Cranberry Hwy for a shoplifter. He arrived and the clerk pointed out the suspect. Officer Kearney approached the suspect, Gary Debrecini, 25, 2875 Cranberry Hwy, Wareham and he became combative. He was subsequently placed under arrest for shoplifting, Disorderly Conduct, Disturbing the Peace, resisting Arrest and several outstanding default warrants.
